I was also teaching at the Bible school in Sierra Ventana in Monterrey. Teaching second Timothy.

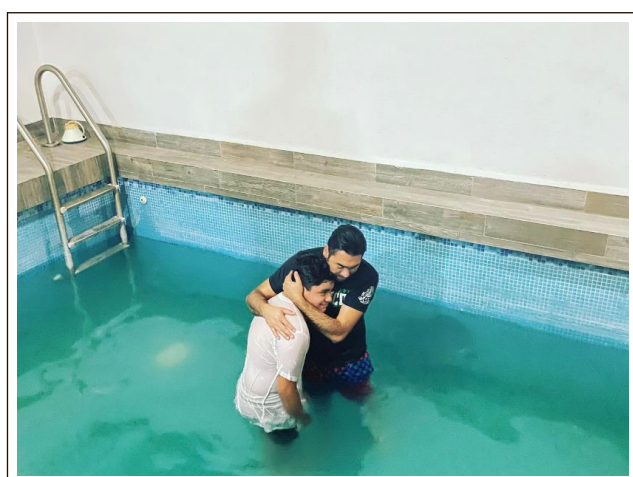


I went to a hospital to visit this man at the request of his whole family part of the church. I preached to him about Jesus and asked for mercy for his life.
